Dear Clive,

I hope this letter finds you well. On behalf of the Governing Body I am writing with a brief report on the awards made by the College from the funds provided by the Lord Crewe Trust. We are so fortunate to enjoy the support of Lord Crewe's Charity and to be able to support so many worthy students, and, of course to maintain a Junior Research Fellow in Music, Dr Jonathan Hicks, who visited Durham earlier this year. I attach a list of award holders in the various categories of grant.

It was with particular pleasure that we were able to award the Lord Crewe Major Scholarship in Humanities to Laura Shell, to enable her to take up a place on the MSt in Classical Archaeology. Laura, a native of Ryton in Co. Durham, and who had been a Lord Crewe Scholar in her final year as an undergraduate at Lincoln, just missed out on winning the University-wide competition for a full postgraduate scholarship in her subject. It was fitting that we were able to support her instead. Sadly, we had no eligible candidate for the analogous award in Social Sciences and so will make two awards in this area to students beginning their courses this coming October.

In March the College's Hardship Committee met to make bursary awards from the Lord Crewe Hardship fund. We had set aside funding for four major awards of £1000 each for necessitous students from the 'Crewe Territories' (Northumbria, County Durham, Lincolnshire and Northamptonshire). We were able to make two awards, to students from Lincolnshire and from North Tyneside. There being no other necessitous students from these counties the remaining sum was added in to the sum available for minor bursaries, ranging from £150 to £300.

It is a remarkable thing to note that, in this year alone, 92 students of Lincoln College have received financial assistance from Lord Crewe's Charity. I cannot think of any other College in Oxford where so many are supported by a single benefaction. On behalf of all these students, and of my colleagues in the Governing Body, I thank the Trustees for their continued concern for the common weal of Lincoln College and its students, and I look forward to the prospect of accompanying some of those students, in the not too distant future, on a trip to Durham to meet the Trustees.
